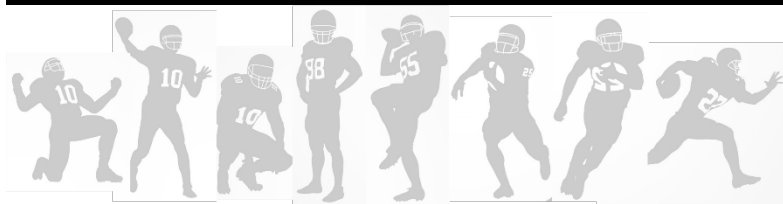

FINANCIAL ASSESSMENT 2026: PAY TO PLAY

(SGYF) IS A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION AND IS BUDGETED SOLELY TO OPERATE ON A 'BREAK-EVEN' BASIS BY THE END OF EACH YEAR. Its Board Members & Coaching Staffs are all "VOLUNTEERS" in this organization---no one is paid for the hundreds of hours in service to the youth in our programs. We provide the highest quality recreational football and cheerleading program at the 'lowest cost' possible! The funds to maintain this goal are derived from player-cheerleader participation fees AND organization fund-raisers; community events, snack bar operations at practices and Saturday home games, and other host events/playoff games and other donations. Our expenses every year include, but not necessarily limited to the following: [1] replacing player uniforms and equipment as needed, [2] replacement & new coaching & team training equipment (FB & CHR), medical kits, [3] reconditioning (cleaning & sanitation) and re-certification of existing helmet and shoulder pad inventory, [4] replacing football helmet & shoulder pad inventory, [5] fees to the Football Conference (AAU), national membership fees, supplies, and other conference requirements, [6] insurance coverage: general liability & secondary medical for participants, [7] field and facility equipment and supplies throughout the year, [8] year-end awards, picture packages & scholastic recognition, [9] snack bar operations & supplies, [10] general administrative expenses of registration materials, advertising, communications, training, team equipment, etc. THE FOLLOWING FEE SCHEDULE PROVIDES THE "PRIVILEGE AND OPPORTUNITY" TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SOUTH GATE AZTECS YOUTH FOOTBALL & CHEER PROGRAMS & DOES NOT GUARANTEE YEAR-END AWARDS & BENEFITS (PLEASE REFER TO THE PARENT HANDBOOK). NON-COMPLIANCE WILL CAUSE IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION OF YOUR CHILD/CHILDREN IN OUR PROGRAMS.

1. _____ **I AGREE & SUBMIT to all SGYF&C and SCEYFL-AAU registration enrollment requirements** for my/our child/children and our enrollment application shall be true and complete, and I am the legal parent/guardian of this registrant. I also agree to ensure we submit all required player/cheerleader documentation as required to "certify" my child per the requirements of the youth football and cheer conference, SCEYFL-AAU. **I understand any delay in providing said documentation will delay or disqualify my child from continued participation and there is NO REFUND.**
2. _____ **I AGREE & SUBMIT this participant (player or cheerleader) has my/our permission to participate in all SGYF&C and SCEYFL-AAU** football and cheer activities for the current season/year and such permission has been given by a responsible legal parent/guardian and authorized adult. Likewise, we shall agree to abide by all the rules of attendance, practice and game participation as required.
3. _____ **I AGREE & SUBMIT the undersigned assumes all risks and hazards of participation** in SGYF&C and SCEYFL-AAU activities including transportation to and from such activities.
4. _____ **I AGREE & UNDERSTAND this organization of youth football and cheerleading is a NON-PROFIT entity subject to the governing rules of the state and federal government.** As such, I/We, the parent/parents acknowledge and understand the SGYF&C organization's primary income is derived from fees collected in the form of registration, uniforms/equipment, and organization fundraisers as written in all registration materials we receive in this registration packet and Parent Handbook.

All income earned through these means is put back into the program services. **As such, I understand our required fees in registration, organization fundraiser, Homecoming and uniforms are REQUIRED for continued participation in the SGYF&C programs, it is not an option, and we agree to submit required fees per the requested due dates.** **Otherwise, we understand we will be charged a 15% late fee, acknowledge a late receipt of the required uniform/s for my child/children, AND immediate**

suspension from continued participation in the SGYF&C programs with the understanding all previous fees paid will be FORFEITED, there is no refund; as well as no uniforms/equipment, no organization benefits. Non-compliance of paid registration, uniforms or fundraisers will change the status of my child/children as a "member not in good standing."

5. _____ **I AGREE & SUBMIT** to understanding the **maximum registration** for each flag team is 20-Players, each tackle team is 25-Players, and each cheer team shall have a minimum of 12 and a maximum of up to 35-Cheerleaders. This is what determines the organization budget. Registration is on a first come, first paid basis, no tryouts are required. The registration cut-off date is scheduled: PHYSICAL DAY. I also understand there may be times when the team is under-registered, however, I further understand the organization will continue to register participants to ensure the team is eligible for competition and they reach the budget required. And this commitment may continue through mid-season. Please know and understand the organization's goal is not about winning, but to ensure our teams are learning and progressing throughout the season and shall enjoy this experience as a member of an Aztec team. We expect the cooperation of our parents as we progress through the season as we will not tolerate negative comments against your team's leadership or this organization. Some teams may be comprised of all new players to this sport, which require at least a season or two to learn the game and to gain the skills and confidence necessary in this sport. However, you always have the choice to go elsewhere.

PROJECTING NEGATIVE COMMENTS TO OTHER PARENTS ABOUT THE TEAM, ITS PLAYERS OR ITS LEADERSHIP, MUST BE DIRECTED TO YOUR HEAD COACH. Doing this is not fair to the team and its players, who are doing their best to navigate and learn this sport. If they are enjoying it, please let them ride it out with this team, win or lose. Giving up is not in our game plan, and we are dedicated to teaching this great sport through good sportsmanship and fair play for everyone. Please feel free to express your concerns to our Head Coach or the Vice President of Football or Cheer. Because we are all volunteers in this organization, we are also not rejecting any criticism or the possibility of adding staff to our rosters.

6. _____ **I AGREE & SUBMIT** to **hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify, and hold harmless** the Team, SGYF&C, SCEYFL-AAU, including without limitation Participants, Sponsors, Volunteers, Board Members, City of South Gate, its Employees, Officials and Directors, Los Angeles Unified School District-Directors and Supervisors appointed by them, for any claim arising out of any injury to the participant named herein. This also includes other facilities outside of the City of South Gate and LAUSD.
7. _____ **I AGREE & SUBMIT TO THE PAYMENT POLICY: Participation/Registration Fees, Uniforms and any required Fund-raisers** must be paid by: CASH, MONEY ORDER, CASHIERS CHECK, CREDIT/DEBIT CARD (Master Card/Visa), VENMO, ZELLE or PERSONAL or SPONSORED CHECKS. \$25 "Returned Check Fee" will be applied for all returned 'bounced' checks processed through the SGYF&C bank. **(All Credit Card payments will include a .02% processing fee).** Very Important on any "digital payments" made via VENMO or ZELLE you must insert a note to indicate the name of the player or cheerleader, the child's team (6U, 8U, etc.), and what the payment is for: registration, cheer uniform, etc., without this we cannot appropriately record your payment.

Our fee and fundraising programs are designed to pay for certain programs

within our organization, and not just for the material items we provide to players, cheerleaders or our teams in the form of organization administrative and team training supplies, admin materials and equipment. This budget is set in February/March of the new year before we begin registration. As a non-profit organization, we do not have the luxury of extra funding. Our funding comes in the form of registration, fundraisers and snack bar operations. When our fees are not paid within the deadline, this puts a substantial financial burden to our program with delays in being able to pay for certain budgeted items (above); particularly uniforms which take weeks to manufacture from our providers. As a non-profit we are obligated by state and federal law to operate on a "break-even" basis, we are not in it to profit! Again, late payments will also guarantee your child's suspension from our programs, late uniforms/equipment, and a late fee penalty of 15%. Again, as a reminder, all fees paid previously are forfeited. There are no refunds.

8. _____ **I AGREE & SUBMIT TO A NO REFUND POLICY:** SHOULD A PLAYER/CHEERLEADER DROP OR QUIT FOR ANY REASON THERE IS NO REFUND OR TRANSFER OF FUNDS PAID FROM ONE PARTICIPANT TO ANOTHER. The same also applies when a participant is deemed to be a "Member Not In Good Standing." The participant also forfeits any year-end benefits or any pre-payment/payment of uniforms/competitions/fundraiser/or other Aztec Items from this organization. **The same policy applies to players/cheerleaders who drop/quit to follow a dismissed head coach/coach during the current season/year. The SGYF&C will always continue to rebuild the team in the event a head coach/coach has been dismissed for violations.**
9. _____ **I AGREE & SUBMIT ALL REGISTRATION FEES MUST BE PAID IN FULL NO LATER THAN THE SCHEDULED "PHYSICAL DAY (7/12/2026)."** You must pay to **play!** Failure to make your registration fee payment by the scheduled due date will cause your child to be suspended from participation and a 15% penalty fee assessed to the unpaid balance; the late fee will accrue week to week until your account balance is current. Registration Fees go towards other payment aspects by providing all that we do as per the Registration Fee Schedule: League Fees, Player-Cheerleader AAU Membership, and other as listed. Failure to pay on time delays our ability to pay for these items in a timely manner.
10. _____ **PLAYER & CHEERLEADER SPIRIT PACK & GAME DAY UNIFORMS. I AGREE AND UNDERSTAND I AM 100% RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COMPLETE PURCHASE OF THE REQUIRED ORGANIZATION SPIRIT PACK (PRACTICE UNIFORM) AND GAME DAY UNIFORMS AS A PLAYER/CHEERLEADER PARTICIPANT IN THE SGYF&C ORGANIZATION.** As such, we promise to make complete payment of said practice and game day uniforms per the posted due dates. Otherwise, we understand failure to make this payment within the due date will DELAY the receipt of said uniforms for my child. **The uniform orders will be placed as scheduled shortly after the designated due date for those who have paid on time. Consequence of late to no uniform payments will automatically suspend my child from continued participation as well as a 15% late fee penalty will be assessed for those who do not pay by the designated due date. Reinstatement to active status will result upon completion of the unpaid uniform balance.** A player/cheerleader who drops/quits for any reason will FORFEIT any and all SGYF&C payments (including uniforms); CHEERLEADER TRAINING IS A MUST & PAID SEPARATELY and information will be provided from your child's Head Coach. Please review all Cheer Handouts provided and/or attached in this registration packet.

11. **I AGREE & SUBMIT TO THE REQUIRED ORGANIZATION FUNDRAISER 2026.**

PLEASE REVIEW THE FUNDRAISING FLYER FOR MORE INFORMATION. I understand registration fees alone do not pay for everything or the benefits to which my participating child/children is entitled to. Increased costs in supplies and materials needed to support the organization budget is achieved through registration fees, organization events (Fireworks Stand and Snack Bar Operations) and participant fundraising campaigns. SGYF&C has scheduled one (1) organization fund-raiser and one (1) event (Homecoming) that requires each player & cheerleader to participate and sell tickets and/or fundraiser products. I understand required sales for an EVENT is needed to pay for the cost of the event (in this case; Homecoming and the Aztec King & Queen Contest) and an ORGANIZATION FUNDRAISER is needed to help supplement the SGYF&C budget not met by registration fees alone for football and cheer. **The following is a requirement for each player/cheerleader registered in our program:**

- A) **ORGANIZATION FUNDRAISER* (AUGUST).** Must sell the minimum sales quota per player/cheerleader as specified in the Fundraiser Handout (\$200 per participant), at the discretion of the organization a special incentive may be provided if sales reach the incentive eligibility amount indicated on the flyer. When sales exceed the incentive level there is only one (1) incentive award provided to the eligible player or cheerleader no matter how much is paid over and above the incentive level. DUE DATE: 08/31/2026. THERE IS NO SIBLING DISCOUNT. A "BUY-OUT" OPTION IS OFFERED AT \$100. **The fundraiser must be paid by the due date or a suspension will be enforced. If you miss the due date, you cannot claim a "buy-out" request and the amount due will be \$150 (not eligible for any fundraiser product). SUSPENSION AND \$150 PAYMENT WILL BE ENFORCED.**

(THE FOLLOWING EVENT IS "WAIVED" (NON-APPLICABLE) DURING THE YEAR OF OUR FOOTBALL SEASON OF SUSPENSION: 2026)

- b) **EVENT: HOMECOMING-AZTEC KING & QUEEN CONTEST (OCTOBER).** Must sell Homecoming Tickets (10-tickets at \$5-each) for a total return of \$50. A Team Aztec King, Queen and Runner-Up Prince or Princess is determined by one of the following actions:
- 1) Whomever sells the most in ticket sales of \$200+
 - 2) A Player or Cheerleaders amount of Snack Bar Donations has exceeded \$200 in product donated. (See the Snack Bar Donation Flyer).
 - 3) The Aztec King, Queen, Prince or Princess shall be crowned and recognized at the half-time crowning ceremony of the child's game.
 - 4) **The fundraiser must be paid by the due date or a 15% penalty and suspension will be enforced.**

Players & Cheerleaders will be issued their required 10 tickets on or about OCTOBER-1st. DUE DATE IS: 10/29/2026.

*** Failure to pay on the required organization fundraiser or the Homecoming Ticket sales, the Participant will be suspended from participation and deemed a "Member Not In Good Standing." Reinstatement can only be achieved once the payment of the Organization Fundraiser and/or Homecoming Ticket Sales is paid in full plus a 15% late fee will be applied for the inconvenience to the organization.**

11. _____ **I AGREE & UNDERSTAND SHOULD MY CHILD BE SUSPENDED FOR NON-PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION, UNIFORMS AND/OR FUNDRAISER;** and should this suspension cause the "forfeiture" of the football team, we will agree to pay the required forfeiture fee of \$865 to the SCEYFL-AAU Conference, and shall be split between other players of the same team also on suspension status for similar non-compliance. **This forfeiture fee shall be due on the date of the upcoming game.** Failure to comply will result in a PERMANENT SUSPENSION from the SGYF&C program and an immediate FORFEITURE of all benefits, payments, uniforms and equipment.
12. _____ **DISCLOSURE:** The scheduled organization dates for all events as noted in this handbook and/or other handouts may change due to unforeseen circumstances, ample notice will be sent to all participants and their parents should such change/changes occur.
13. _____ **I AGREE & SUBMIT TO ACKNOWLEDGE AND ABIDE BY THE SGYF&C/SCEYFL-AAU ADULT CODE OF CONDUCT,** a required document of participation & certification in SCEYFL-AAU and posted at all SGYF&C games and events. Unsportsmanlike conduct in any form will not be tolerated at practices, games or other organization events and activities and an adult will be escorted from the facility, and a suspension of the affected player/cheerleader may also be in effect.
14. _____ **I AGREE & SUBMIT TO THE CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION. ANY AND ALL BENEFITS AS OUTLINED IN SGYF&C HANDBOOK OR OTHER SGYF&C PUBLICATION IS FORFEITED BY THE PARTICIPANT SHOULD THEY QUIT, DROP or DISMISSED AS A "MEMBER NOT IN GOOD STANDING" FROM THE TEAM FOR ANY REASON AT ANY TIME (Includes pre- and post-season play). PARTICIPANT MUST REMAIN IN 'GOOD STANDING' TO BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE REWARDS AND GIFTS AT THE YEAR-END CEREMONY.** A participant in 'Good Standing' is defined as meeting all conditions of participation: 1) Payment of all required fees & events/fundraisers, 2) Payment of all required Practice and Game Uniforms, 3) Fulfillment of required volunteer service hours (we require parent volunteer hours at home games or playoff events, [see the Parent Volunteer Policy](#)), 4) Return of all loaned equipment, or 5) Other as required by SGYF&C, written notice will be provided. 5) The Organization shall provide a scheduled "Year-End Awards Ceremony," ([Food is not provided by the organization, unless it is sponsored or the team fundraising provides for it, or the team implements a potluck of food item contributions by parents and staff.](#))

_____ **A scheduled SGYF&C Awards Ceremony/Banquet cannot be boycotted otherwise, year-end benefits will be forfeited,** this event is scheduled as an Aztec Family Event requiring the attendance of all player/cheerleader participants of a team to be individually recognized, the organization has taken extraordinary lengths to ensure the event is scheduled and an adequate facility is available, as well as costs for certificates, etc.

15. _____ **I AGREE & SUBMIT TO THE SGYF&C POLICY REGARDING UNAUTHORIZED PERSONAL PROFIT.**

- a) AZTEC SPIRIT WEAR. I/WE ALSO ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE THAT I/WE DO NOT HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO MANUFACTURE, DUPLICATE ANY AZTEC LOGO/LOGOS, SGYF&C SPIRIT WEAR (T-SHIRTS, HATS, JACKETS, SWEATSHIRTS, OR OTHER

ITEMS SUCH AS TARPS, ETC.), NEITHER BY USE OF ITS COLORS, LOGOS, OR NAME; SGYF&C HAS IT'S OWN LINE OF ORGANIZATION SPIRIT WEAR AVAILABLE THROUGH ITS DIRECTOR OF AZTEC SPIRIT SALES, AND ANY SUCH AUTHORIZATION MUST RECEIVE THE APPROVAL OF THE SGYF&C PRESIDENT. ALSO...

- c) **VIOLATION OF THIS AGREEMENT WILL CAUSE IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL OF THE RELATED PLAYER OR CHEERLEADER, BOARD MEMBER, HEAD COACH, TEAM MANAGER OR COACHING STAFF. NO ONE CAN PARTICIPATE IN THIS ORGANIZATION FOR PERSONAL PROFIT!**

14. **_____ I AGREE & SUBMIT TO AUTHORIZATION FOR PUBLICATION PURPOSES:**

In addition, by accepting this agreement, I consent to have my child/children interviewed, photographed, audio/video recorded and its/their release, publication, exhibition, or reproduction to be used for advertising, promotional purposes, inclusion on web sites, social media sites or any other purpose by the SGYF&C, Inc. and its affiliates and representatives to promote our program. You release, the Team, SGYF&C, SCEYFL-AAU, including without limitation Participants, Sponsors, Volunteers, Board Members, City of South Gate, its Employees, Officials and Directors, Los Angeles Unified School District-Directors and Supervisors appointed by them from any and all liability and monetary gain connected with the taking, recording, publication of interviews, exhibitions, reproduction, photographs, computer images, video and/or or sound recordings of your child/children. COMMUNICATION AP AGREEMENT: While a participant or member in the SGYF&C/SCEYFL-AAU organization you agree on behalf of you and your family members not to use social media or the team communication AP in an "unsportsmanlike behavior" or "violate the Adult Code of Conduct;" the name/names of SGYF&C/SCEYFL-AAU shall not be used in Social Media/team communication AP that is defamatory, or of a derogatory nature or unsportsmanlike. Such violation will suspend the child/participant/member immediately. This also includes any video posted to social media that reflects poorly upon the conduct of a parent or participant in the SGYF&C/SCEYFL-AAU organization.

- a) Please take note: The TEAM COMMUNICATION AP/TEXTS, or other, is strictly used by the SGYF&C Head Coach, Team Manager or other Executive Officer to inform parents about organization reminders, calendared events, etc. It is strictly used as "information only." It is not to be used to act unsportsmanlike or use derogatory language towards

any person associated with this organization or conference, violators will be suspended, including their child/children.

16. **I AGREE & SUBMIT AS A PARENT OF A FLAG OR TACKLE FOOTBALL PLAYER IN REGARD TO LOANED UNIFORMS & EQUIPMENT:** The undersigned shall agree to assume all responsibility and uphold the SGYF&C UNIFORM/EQUIPMENT LIABILITY AGREEMENT and to acknowledge that any SGYF&C equipment/uniforms issued to my child shall be my/our responsibility for proper care and maintenance while in our possession. **The loaned uniforms & equipment issued to your child is the sole property of the SGYF&C, Inc. organization and you do not have the authority to make claim of ownership or hold our property hostage for any reason.** Players must wear organization-provided helmets and shoulder pads, replacing any portion of said equipment is not allowed. (This includes face masks, which will null & void our helmet warranty). Any violation of the SGYF&C Uniform/Equipment Liability Agreement will result in my child's suspension and/or ineligibility to claim any year end awards including reimbursement to SGYF&C for the replacement cost of said item per signed Uniform & Equipment Liability Agreement.

17. **I AGREE & SUBMIT TO THE PRE-SEASON CONDITIONING & TRAINING.** Our primary purpose for conducting pre-season conditioning and training for both football and cheer during the months of March through June is for "recruitment" purposes. We utilize this opportunity to bring youth football and cheerleading to our community. Although this is "not required" as part of our registration agreement, it is essential in preparing young student-athletes for the season ahead. WE DO NOT OWE YOU THIS OPPORTUNITY, AS SOME ASSUME WE DO! When conditions and facilities are available, our goal has always been focused on recruiting new student-athletes into our program and provide all who wish to participate an opportunity to condition in the pre-season months at NO COST!

WHY A RETURNING PLAYER OR CHEERLEADER SHOULD TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE PRE-SEASON CONDITIONING & TRAINING?

ABOUT THE ACADEMY?

Simply put, conditioning is essential in every sport. Players & Cheerleaders need to prepare their bodies for the movements they'll make during a game. They must warm up those muscles, build endurance, and maintain strength and flexibility. Our focus in our academy is to introduce the elements of football & cheerleading training & conditioning for any student-athlete wanting to come out and see if this is the sport for them; to learn the skills and train like a football player or cheerleader. We will run our student-athletes through various stations designed to teach and build the necessary physical capabilities of:

- Cardiovascular training to help increase your fitness
- Resistance training to build muscle strength and address any muscle imbalances that you may have
- Flexibility training to allow your joints to move through their full range of motion
- Speed and agility training are important for sports involving quick changes of direction or speed

- Sports specific drills to ensure your body is ready for all the challenges of our sport!

FOR RETURNING PLAYERS & CHEERLEADERS:

Many sports are not played all year round, which means that most players have a period where they are not training or competing. Whether it be soccer, rugby, netball or athletics, pre-season training and injury assessment is essential in preparing for the next season. Muscle strength, endurance and conditioning decline during the periods that you are not training or competing. Suddenly going back to the high demands of your sport without adequate conditioning will place your body at risk of injury, as it is not equipped to cope with the challenges of your sport. Your body will need to regain fitness, flexibility and strength to prepare you for the season ahead.

18. _____ **I AGREE & SUBMIT that the SGYF&C organization reserves the right to 'NOT ALLOW PARTICIPATION' of players or cheerleaders whose parent/parents have conducted themselves in an "unsportsmanlike" manner in current and/or in previous year/years.** THIS SHALL ALSO INCLUDE A PARTICIPANT WHOSE BEHAVIOR, ATTITUDE AND CONDUCT IS QUESTIONABLE FROM A PREVIOUS SEASON/YEAR. This refers to any documented notice in violation of the SGYF&C/SCEYFL-AAU Adult Code of Conduct Rules noted in a previous season/year. When 'ineligibility' situations occur or are in question, it shall be determined by the existing Executive Board of Directors which may result in a parent being placed on probation when participation has been allowed/approved. Otherwise, participation is denied where violations of conduct have occurred in previous season/year or years, particularly use of alcohol/alcoholic beverages at practice and/or game day venues.
19. _____ **I AGREE & SUBMIT TO DISCLOSURE REGARDING WAIVER OF LAWSUIT:** Each person participating in the South Gate Youth Football, Inc., AKA South Gate Youth Football & Cheer Organization or South Gate Aztecs; board members, coaches, parents, players and cheerleaders must sign a written Contract, this Registration Application. Among the provisions of this Contract are: It requires all persons involved in the program to give up any legal right that they would have to file a lawsuit against South Gate Youth Football, Inc. [SGYF&C] or its parent organization: SCEYFL-AAU in which it is alleged that SGYF&C and/or SCEYFL-AAU or either of its officers, directors or coaches has failed to follow the SGYF&C or SCEYFL-AAU rules. In the past, lawsuits which complained that the way either SGYF&C or SCEYFL-AAU has enforced the rules as being unfair or wrong; historically, the courts have ruled that because SGYF&C and SCEYFL-AAU are all "volunteer organizations" the courts should not get involved in what amounts to a private dispute. Generally, the courts take the view that the remedy of a parent, players, cheerleader or coach which feels that they have been the subject of an unfair or wrong decision is to resign from the organization and join a different organization whose views are more in line with the person who feels offended. All of our leadership are “volunteers” whereby no one gets paid for the hundreds of hours of leadership service to the organization programs. **Our budget is 100% dependent upon the prompt payment of participant registration and fundraiser fees---FEES ARE NOT AN OPTION, YOU PAY TO PLAY AND ALSO ALLOWS YOU THE PRIVILEGE AND OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN OUR PROGRAMS.** Practice Uniforms, Game Day and Competition Uniforms will be paid for by the parent. Practice and Game Day Uniforms will remain the same as 2025. New Players and Cheerleaders must pay the required fees for the uniform packages as described in the SGYF&C Practice & Game Day Uniform Price Sheet 2026. The following has been written to educate our parents as to the rules and regulations that govern our organization as a nonprofit. We are including this criterion as part of our **2026-27 REGISTRATION PACKET** so there is no misunderstanding in how we operate financially; establish our registration fees, and the required fundraisers and uniforms that you are obligated to pay. You must acknowledge receipt of all provided documents, either digitally or printed on paper, and you shall agree to review said registration documents with a full understanding of your financial obligations to this organization. Thus, you cannot make any claim against this organization in not providing you a complete written obligation of our fees. **NO ONE REGISTERS IN OUR PROGRAMS OF FOOTBALL OR CHEERLEADING WITHOUT A VERBAL DISCUSSION ABOUT OUR REQUIRED FEES FOLLOWED BY A WRITTEN DOCUMENT OF ALL FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS INCLUDING ITS DUE DATES** (Said documents may be sent to the parent via email or provided as a printed handout).

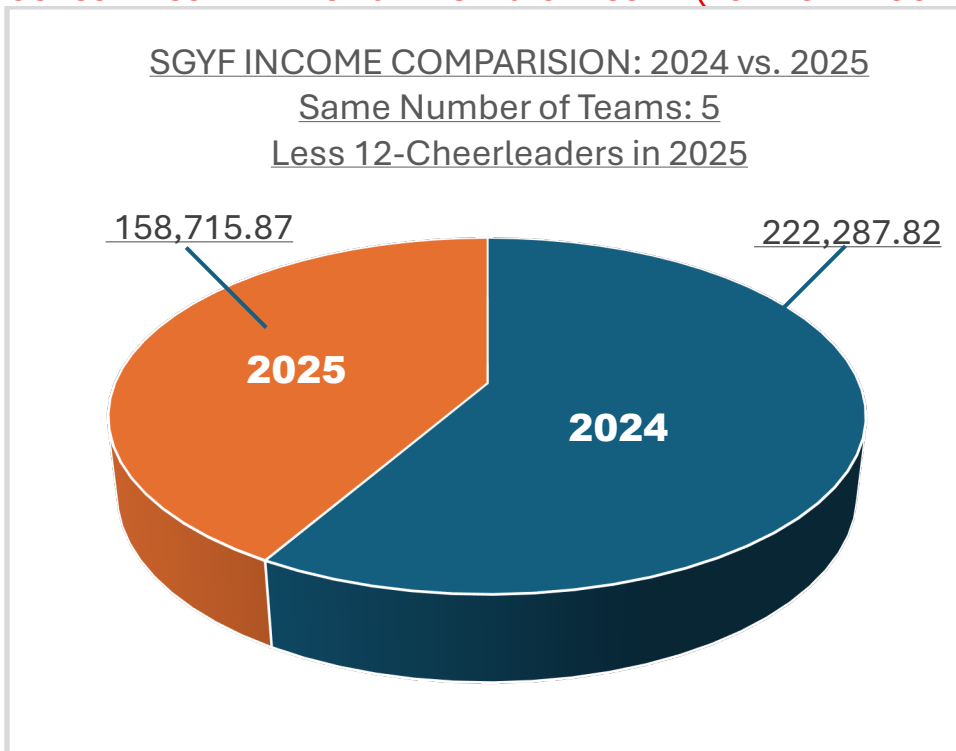
WHEN YOU JOIN A NON-PROFIT, YOU MUST UNDERSTAND HOW THE FINANCES OF THE PROGRAM WORKS? SO THAT WE CAN AVOID ANY MISUNDERSTANDING OF WHO WE ARE? HOW ARE FUNDS GENERATED AS A NON-PROFIT YOUTH ORGANIZATION? WHAT IS A BUDGET AND HOW THE FEES ARE DETERMINED?...

1. Since 1990, we have been registered as a legal non-profit corporation, a youth football & cheer organization, with the state and federal government. Various paperwork and fees must be filed annually to maintain this legal status.
2. We generate funds to fulfill a budget of income and expenses, which is written and approved by the Executive Board each New Year on or about March at a special financial review meeting.
 - a. The budget is determined by the number of registrants we expect for each football and cheer team, the number of adult volunteers, and this budget must include the projected cost of everything (*league fees & insurance, uniforms, equipment, training, administrative, registration materials, etc.*), as well as the projected income from our approved fees (registrations, uniforms, fundraisers, etc.).
 - b. The projected expenditure budget is then appropriately divided between the number of registrants in our programs for both football and cheerleading (which must equal to or slightly more than our projected income). This is what determines our fees for (1) Registration, (2) Organization Fundraiser and (3) Homecoming.
 - c. Understanding the costs for the above are not the same from year-to-year, prices go up and thus the expenditure budget must be close to the actual cost.
3. We are **not subsidized by the city** to help fund our operations; other than they pay for our facility permits for practices and games, since none is available through the park. We must generate our own income from the fees we have established that are consistent with our approved budget and on a break-even basis, we do not carry over excess income. However, when we do not make our income budget we will, in most cases, have carryover debt, as was the situation in **2025**. The income budget did not meet the needs of the expenditure budget due to a lack of participants paying their required fees (registration and fundraiser), and the number of excessive drops who owed fees, all expected to contribute to the income budget. That deficit totaled over \$17,000 of income we expected from our fees of participation including the required fundraiser. **And because of this, our program has been rewritten to avoid such a financial setback, as we cannot provide "free" service and goods to our participants and policies have been put into place to ensure against this in our future, such as**

but not limited to, 15% late fee and suspension of the participant. In the case of uniforms, we will no longer delay placement of our orders while waiting for everyone to pay their fees. The due dates will be enforced, and we will place our orders on schedule. Those who pay late will receive their uniforms at a much later date.

4. As you review the data below, you must understand OUR COST FOR EVERYTHING increased substantially in 2025 by the government Tariffs put in place after we approved our budget, as the same happened for every family in America.

IN 2025 WE DID NOT MEET OUR FOOTBALL REGISTRATION BUDGET FOR THE SAME NUMBER OF TEAMS HELD IN 2024; WE WERE DOWN 41% IN FOOTBALL REGISTRATIONS. THIS IS THE OUTCOME COMPARING 2024 VS. 2025 INCOME (FOR BOTH FOOTBALL & CHEER) ...



5. **When a parent registers a player or cheerleader in our programs, it is a "condition of participation" that our fees for registration, spirit packs, game uniforms, competition uniforms, organization fundraiser and Homecoming be paid in full by the required due dates.** It's what is referred to as our budget which must be met to pay for the items as described in line item #2a above. Consequences in not making the payment on its due dates will result in a late penalty fee of 15% of the balance owed and immediate suspension of the participant, no matter what the consequence of the team.
6. **Starting 2026 and beyond, the responsibility of paying the football player and cheerleader spirit pack, game uniforms and competition uniforms will now be the responsibility of the parent.** Payments not received at the due date will result in a late return of the affected player/cheerleader uniform item; payment must be made in full. And only those for whom we have received payments on time shall we then place their uniform order. Please understand, without a uniform you cannot participate in our scheduled games/events.

- a) **IN THE CASE OF CHEER UNIFORMS IN 2025.** The organization was put into a position of penalizing those who had paid their required fees on or before the scheduled due date, while waiting for everyone to complete their payments. Yes, we agreed it was unfair to those who paid on time, however, while it took 4-5 months after the due dates, the organization simply did not have the income to pay for this in advance. We had no choice but to wait for the complete payment before ordering, as no vendor was willing to ship the uniforms until payment was received in full. And insofar as, the cheer uniform was concerned, all handouts, the Parent Handbook and uniform fitting forms specifically stated: **LATE PAYMENTS WOULD DELAY UNIFORMS FOR EVERYONE!**

ADULT CODE OF CONDUCT (PARENT)



Adopted: September 05, 2006

The objective of the SOUTH GATE AZTECS YOUTH FOOTBALL & CHEER ORGANIZATION (SGYF&C) is to inspire youth, regardless of race, color, creed, or national origin, to practice the ideals of health, citizenship, and character; to bring our youth closer together through the means of a common interest in sportsmanship, fair play, and fellowship; to impart to the game elements of safety, sanity and intelligent supervision; and to keep the welfare of the player first, foremost and entirely free of adult lust for glory.

In order to keep the program free of adult lust for glory and other adult misconduct detrimental to the ideals of youth sports; parents/guardians and spectators of football players and cheerleaders as well as all adults connected with or who participate in the SGYF&C Program must adhere to these standards of conduct as it pertains to any interaction (including use of Social Media or Team Communication APS) with coaches, football players, cheerleaders, SGYF&C/SCEYFL-AAU and its Chapter Members (including Game Day Officials on the field) and other parents/spectators involved in the program:

1. I will remember, as an adult associated with SGYF&C I have a unique and privileged opportunity to be a positive influence on the lives of our child/children. I will not waste that opportunity.
2. I will remember that the members of the opposing team are children that deserve---& may well need caring attention & encouragement from a responsible adult like me.
3. I agree that I will not publicly argue with or disparage my child's head coach & coaching staff, SGYF&C Executive Board Member, game officials, and the opposing team, to opposing coaches or fans.
4. I agree that I will not use abusive or profane language before any person connected with the Program during any football or cheerleading event/activity.
5. I will not physically or verbally threaten/abuse anyone connected with the football or cheerleading organization.
6. I shall not disseminate personal information on other members of SGYF&C, such as involvement in gossip, criticism, false statements, or other personal business not of your own to spread, discuss, rumor, speak about to others, etc.
7. I shall agree to abide by the "rules of the field" whether I am at home or at a visiting location and will give cooperative support to the direction of the assigned Officer on the field.
8. I will not seek to undermine the authority of the coaching staff, SGYF&C Officers or any other person connected with the football/cheerleading organization.
9. I will always set an appropriate example by my conduct in front of all people connected with the Program, & will not incite unsportsmanlike conduct.
10. I will accept the decisions of the organization's officers, board members, and coaches as being fair & made to the best ability of the organization's officers, board members and coaches given their volunteer status.
11. I shall not instigate or involve myself to incite unrest or melee at any SGYF&C event/activity, or to involve myself and encourage others to join in a personal campaign to unlawfully present myself and others at the personal home of any SGYF&C leadership. Mob-like mentality and actions will get you dismissed from the organization. You must communicate directly to the Executive Board of Directors and request a one-on-one meeting to seek resolve to your issues.

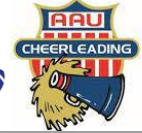
